



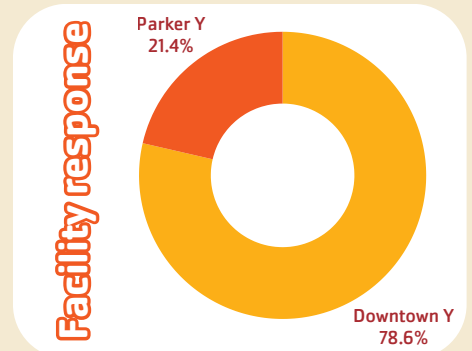
135 COMMUNITY TEAM MONTHLY SNAPSHOT

KEY TAKEAWAY

March feedback showed that when people actually experience the Y—in a class, at an event, or through the Impact Report—they discover far more than expected. The “I had no idea” pattern was the dominant theme. Awareness of the Y’s full community scope remains the biggest opportunity for growth.



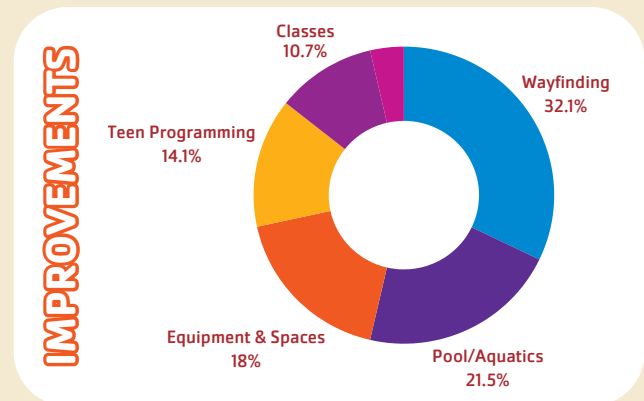
“Both the information shared by staff and the details in the impact report have greatly changed my understanding of what the Y is — it is so much more than just a place to work out.”

FEEDBACK FOCUS

March feedback pointed to two clear signals: belonging works—the Y’s welcoming atmosphere and staff warmth topped every ask type — and awareness is still the biggest gap. Team members at both campuses discovered services, spaces, and programs they had no idea existed. Getting people through the door remains the most powerful tool.
