Team participants turned their attention to the Parker YMCA in Milton — touring the branch, trying out spaces, lending a hand on a special outdoor project, and walking the newly gifted outdoor land.

What they found: a small building doing big things, a growing community ready for more from their Y, and a piece of property that could shape the next chapter for the Y in Milton.

WHAT STOOD OUT

Theme 1

The land is the story.

24 of 37 team members named the new outdoor space as Parker’s biggest opportunity — pointing to partnerships, walking trails, a possible pool, athletic fields, and gathering spaces for the whole community.

Theme 2

Parker offers more than people realize.

Members were repeatedly surprised by what Parker contains — full-time childcare, a virtual workout studio and 24/7 access. Even people already in the Y movement said, “I had no idea.”

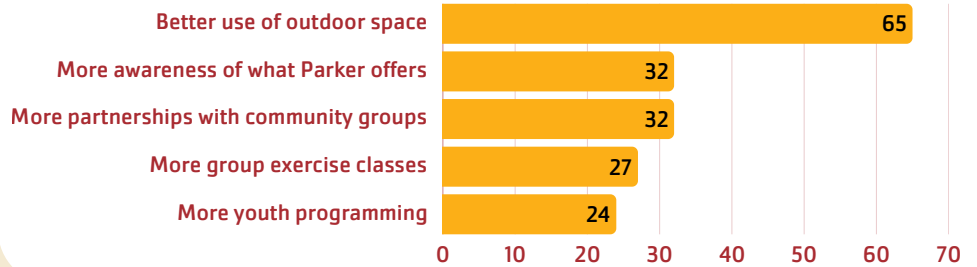
Theme 3

Growth is visible.

Childcare waitlists, busy weeknights, and team members handing out free passes to neighbors — the demand at Parker and around Parker’s property is visible, and it’s growing faster than the building.
